CARE

To enhance health and well-being among community members by providing social services and financial assistance.

EMPOWERMENT

To empower and build the resilience of our community members sustainably through education and training.

SOCIAL REFORM

A human-centric approach in engaging various actors in society to shape a better environment for the vulnerable and marginalised in Hong Kong.

STOP TRAFFICKING OF PEOPLE

The Stop Trafficking of People (STOP) programme focuses on assisting survivors of exploitation and human trafficking.

Care - Provides casework support to those in need, living assistance, as well as medical, and legal referrals.

Empowerment – Promotes knowledge of rights and support options to vulnerable communities in Hong Kong through outreach, workshops and multi-lingual resources.

Social Reform - Conducts research into human trafficking and exploitation in HK. The team published 'A Pathway to Justice or a Road to Nowhere? Trafficked migrants' experience of seeking justice in Hong Kong" in May 2023.



The Refugee Opportunity and Development (ROAD) programme supports refugees and non-refoulement claimants (asylum seekers).

Care - Provides consultation and financial assistance, as well as support in accessing healthcare, counselling and legal services through referrals to partner organisations.

Empowerment - Runs an extensive education support programme for Kindergarten and Primary aged students, as well as vocational training and employment support for adults.

Social Reform - Partners with schools, corporates and NGOs for public education and society integration campaigns.



WHY "HOME & AWAY"?

"Home & Away" is a football term that refers to whether a team is playing at 'home' in their own venue, or away in someone else's.

We hope this tournament will raise awareness and funds for refugees, asylum-seekers and human-trafficking survivors living in Hong Kong. We share a message that while they are away from home and separated from their families, our city is one that cares.

We also hope this event will provide a place for the marginalised and vulnerable to enjoy football with different individuals in Hong Kong, and as a result form genuine friendships. Moreover, we aim to facilitate social integration across the city where all can feel cared for and experience a "Home away from Home".
