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1	Venue Set-up and	Working with the BOH team on venue set-up and wrap-
	Wrap-up	up, including pitch preparation, signage around the venue,
		set-up and wrap-up for the Impact and Family Corners,
		registration desks and first aid/physio booths.
2	Navigation Support	Assisting participating teams and other guests as they
		arrive and navigate through different sections of the
		venue.
3	Registration Support	Assisting BOH staff at the Registration Desk, welcoming
		and registering participating players, their families and
		booth organisers. Ensuring team captains and booth
		organisers arrive on time. Serving as the first point of
		contact for all questions and re-directing questions to
		relevant personnel for handling.
4	Team Support	Supporting RAS community teams and other playing
		teams through the day. Ensuring team members are
		present at ready at their match timings. Serving as the
		point of contact for team members and their families.
5	Time keeper	Ensuring timely execution of key event activities like
		registration, game play, lunch breaks and opening/closing
		ceremony. Working with the Emcee to ensure smooth
		execution, handling of delays and ad-hoc scheduling needs
		on the day of the event.
6	Score keeper	Liaising with referees to calculate team scores at the end
		of each game. Coordinating with the BOH team to
		manage and update the scoreboard through the event.
7	Family Corner Booth	Planning and executing games/activities for families to
	Organiser	enjoy through the day. Managing booth set-up and wrap
		up. Example: face painting, carnival games, arts and crafts,
		nail painting/art, puppet shows, story read-a-louds.



8	Family Corner Support	Supporting Booth Organisers at the Family Corner. Ensuring timely attendance and set-up, assisting them with help they need through the day, helping manage guests at the booths and assisting with booth wrap up.
9	General Support	Assist with set-up, wrap-up and moving of things during the event. Supporting other teams with additional bandwidth, ad-hoc support and relieving volunteers for lunch breaks.
10	Photographers	Capturing pictures of the teams, the games, the opening/closing ceremony and of the other planned activities throughout the day. Uploading the entire set within 48 hours after the event and editing shortlisted pictures. Note: Photographers would need to bring their own cameras and we appreciate interest from photographers with previous experience.
