Purpose(s) of employing the consultant:

The ROAD Summer School Project Coordinator will organize a 3-week summer school for 50 refugee and asylum seekers children from Primary 1 to Primary 6 during 4 Aug to 22 Aug 2025. The coordinator will be responsible for planning classes, coordinating volunteers, student recruitment, and managing the day-to-day activities of the summer school program.

- Develop a comprehensive plan for the summer school program, including curriculum, schedules, and activities.
- · Coordinate with volunteers, including recruitment, training, and scheduling.
- Manage the day-to-day operations of the summer school program, including overseeing classes, activities, and events.
- Ensure the safety and well-being of all participants in the program.
- · Maintain accurate records of attendance, progress, and other important information.
- Communicate regularly with parents, guardians, and other stakeholders regarding program updates and progress.
- Coordinate with community organizations, schools, and other partners to ensure the success of the program.
- Manage program budget and resources, including supplies, equipment, and facilities.
- Create a project report after completion of summer school.
- Any other task as assigned by superior(s) from time to time.
